



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Economic Impact

Sled Island is not just a cultural event, but a vital contributor to Calgary's economy.

In 2023, Tourism Calgary conducted an Economic Impact Report for Sled Island.

The report revealed:

Total Economic Impact of the festival: \$3.05M This included job creation in the lodging, transport, recreation, retail, and food & beverage industries


Year-Round Programming

While Sled Island is mostly known for its annual festival, our team works year-round to create events catering to musicians and audiences of all ages and backgrounds.

We strongly believe in the role that arts play in strengthening the cultural fabric of our city, and we strive to make the local music community more inclusive and welcoming to all with events such as the Rock Lotto and our All-Ager Rager.



Sled Island Rock Lotto





The Rock Lotto is an outreach initiative with the goal to foster a more diverse music ecosystem and increase equitable access to creative opportunities for all.

This events brings together 25 musicians from various backgrounds whose names are drawn from a hat to form one-off bands for one night only, with just 12 hours to write and perform new material.

We work with the Calgary Catholic Immigration Society, Centre for Newcomers, and the Immigrant Council for Arts Innovation to connect newcomer musicians with artists familiar with the Calgary music scene.
